#### Session 4

# **Fellowship**

Pray: praise God and thank Him together, ask Him to provide for our needs, ask Him to heal the sick and save the lost. (This is a good time to ask about their opportunities to share with people on their list – or share your own experiences – rejoice together, encourage one another –or you can do this in the review time below)

Sing: Teach the believers a song of praise to God. For example "Hallelu":

Hallelu, Hallelu, Hallelu, Hallelujah, Praise ye the Lord (2xs)
Praise ye the Lord, Hallelujah; praise ye the Lord, Hallelujah, praise ye the Lord,
Hallelujah, praise ye the Lord!
(2 Shukron li Rrubb, 3 magdan li Rrubb)

## Read God's Word:

- 1. John 5:17. Say: What Allah is doing in our city (or our country) is important!
- 2. Satan is not happy and will try to stop us from joining Allah. I Peter 5:8-10; not only will Satan make war against us, but he will make war with the people we tell about Isa (Mark 4:15). Have someone read Mark 10:29-31. Ask the believers, "What does Jesus promise us if we leave everything to follow and obey Him?" Read 2 Timothy 3:12. Ask the believers, "What does this verse teach us about persecution?"
- 3. How can we be ready for this spiritual war? Ephesians 6:10-20; James 4:7. We must know that Allah is truly Great! Romans 8:28. Read Matthew 10:16-20. Ask the believers, "What does Jesus promise to do for us when we face persecution?"

## Review

"Keep the commands of Christ"

- CPM proverbs
   Mouth to ear (What does this mean today?)
   Who, what, where, when? (What does this mean?)
- 2. Gospel presentation. Ask if they have shared with those prayed for. Roman's road; 3:23, 6:23, 5:8, 10:9.
- 3. Personal Testimony. Ask if they have given their personal testimony to a family member.

**New Teaching** (Say, "Now we will have a new teaching from the injeel today.")

Isa sends us to find Persons of Peace: Luke 10:1-16

We are the workers in His harvest fields.

Pray for the workers. The workers:

Go with danger all around.

Leave behind bags or anything that hinders.

Do not waste time.

Declare the Peace of God.

Bless the household.

Stay with the family long enough to preach the whole gospel and give the family a chance to accept Jesus as Lord and Savior. Train the family if they accept the Truth.

Accept the hospitality given by the family.

Heal any sick people in the household.

Proclaim the Kingdom of God (Jesus).

Leave this family or town if the message is rejected.

Declare judgment if the message is rejected – Jesus will return and take to heaven only those who believe in Him.

Characteristics of the Person of Peace.

The Person of Peace will **Receive** you; Luke 10:6-8

The Person of Peace will **Respond** positively to Jesus (they will accept Him as Lord and Savior): Luke 10:9

The Person of Peace will **Refer** you to their family; Acts 16:11-40 (Lydia and the Philippian jailer are examples of Persons of Peace).

Say, "The Person of Peace is someone, like Lydia, in whom God is already working – they are ready to receive the gospel!"

Ask the believers, "Is there someone close to you in whom you think God is working?"
