

Session 6

Fellowship (1/3 of session) Sing a song and pray together, the trainer should be leading the worship time/songs and prayer time with some prompting. Enjoy a common meal where everyone contributes (go out for ice cream). Read Colossians 3:15 – 17 or similar passage. The house church model is the process for all training. Remember process over content.

Introduction to the first few lessons (This reminder of inevitable persecution is repeated in the fellowship third of the session). We need to remind the trainers that Allah is at work in our city and that He wants us to join Him in this work, and that His work in our city is very important.

1. What Allah is doing in our city is important!
John 5:17.
2. Satan is not happy and will try to stop us from joining Allah.
I Peter 5:8-9; not only will Satan make war against us, but he will make war with the people we tell about Isa, Mark 4:15.
3. How can we be ready for this spiritual war?
Ephesians 6:10-20; James 4:7. We must know that Allah is truly Great! Romans 8:28.

Review (Fellowship - 1/3 of session)

1. What does a person of peace do?
2. What are the 5 truths revealed about Isa in the Qur'an?
3. Find the Bridge verses to one truth from the Qur'an.

Content (1/3 of session) Introduce as a “new teaching” from the Ingeel (Assurance and Cost)

1. New CPM Proverb “Two sides of the same coin” Demonstrate one coin (two sides).
Side 1: The assurance of salvation. Allah assures us of salvation (in Al Masih). Allah yuwakid li'khalas filmasih.
John 5:24; 10:25-30 (demonstrate how it is impossible for someone to take a coin from your hand). Our salvation is in Allah's strong hand.
Romans 8:31-39; 2 Corinthians 5:17; 1 John 1:1-9; 5:11-15; John 14:1-3
It is not just “ensha'allah”. Allah, Himself assures us. Allah yuwakid! God assures us Himself because our salvation is His work, in His hand.

Side 2: The cost of discipleship, or of following Isa.
John 3:27-30. What must I do if Isa is to be great in my life?
Luke 9:57-62; Luke 14:25-33. What is more important than following Isa?
John 14:1-11; John 10:30. When you follow Isa, who are following in truth?
Mark 8:31-38; It is difficult to follow Isa.
Matthew 19:28-30 Are you happy that you follow Isa?

Romans 12:1-2; Galatians 2:19-20.

Accountability and Practice (1/3 of session)

Accountability

1. Share the good news of the assurance of salvation with your family and your new believers. Write the first names of those you will share this good before the next session. By now your trainer probably has believers he/she is training.
2. Memorize Galatians 2:20.
3. Review the list of names you covenanted to share with from the previous session. Add any new names of persons of peace and promise to share with these before the next session.
4. Continue reading the Camel Training Manual in Arabic.

Practice

1. Practice with each other using the new Scripture in how you will tell your family and new believers that God promises the assurance of their salvation.
2. Pray together, thanking Allah for His work, and his word that makes for the assurance of salvation.
